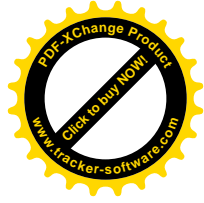
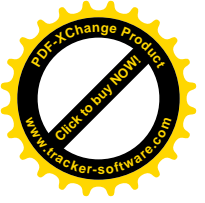
Expanded Course Outline

- I. Introduction
 - A. Course check-in

- II. Course description
 - A. Through lecture, demonstration, practical application, and testing this 8 hour course will provide the officer with the following:
 - 1. Tactical skills needed to function with a Red dot equipped handgun in law enforcement operations.
 - 2. Knowledge of how to maintain, clean and zero a Red dot aiming system.
 - 3. Knowledge of CPD policy and requirements to field a red dot equipped handgun on duty

- III. Course objectives: The student will be able to:
 - A. Understand the policy parameters related to red dot handguns
 - B. Proper inspection and maintenance procedure
 - 1. Cleaning and maintenance
 - 2. Zeroing adjustments
 - 3. Lens care
 - C. Demonstrate basic fundamentals
 - 1. Stance
 - 2. Grip
 - 3. Clearing
 - 4. Loading
 - 5. Unloading.
 - D. Demonstrate proper zeroing, the aiming process, and proficiency at various known and unknown distances.
 - 1) Accurately fire from stationary and moving positions.
 - E. Pass a qualification course
 - 1) 80% or better.

- IV. Classroom safety
 - A. No weapons will be allowed in the classroom
 - 1. All adjustments and hands on activity will be done in the range
 - 2. Instructors will have students store any gear in range prior to starting the class



- V. Range safety rules
 - A. Treat every weapon as if it were loaded.
 - B. Never point a firearm at anything or anybody you do not intend to shoot or in a direction where an unintentional discharge may do harm.
 - C. Never place your finger into the trigger guard or on the trigger until ready to fire (master grip).
 - D. Be sure of your target, backstop and beyond.
 - E. Obey all range commands immediately.
 - F. Never go forward of the firing line unless directed to do so.
 - G. Download your weapon into the berm or in a safe direction.
 - H. All personnel on the range shall wear eye and ear protection during shooting.
