Council Member Christopher Flores is a licensed Real Estate Broker and Property Manager. Fueled by a desire to serve his community, he ran an energetic grass-roots campaign and was elected to represent District 1 on the Chino City Council in 2020.

Council Member Flores sits on numerous City Council committees and is the Council representative to various bodies. He serves on the City of Chino Public Financing Authority, Investment Advisory Committee, the Housing Committee, and the Solid Waste Committee. Additionally, he represents the City in the Chino Valley Chamber of Commerce, the Ontario International Airport Inter-Agency Collaborative, the San Bernardino County Solid Waste Advisory Task Force, and the West Valley Mosquito & Vector Control District.

Community engagement and volunteerism in support of local organizations fill much of Council Member Flores' time outside of work and the City Council. He enjoys meeting regularly with community stakeholders – residents, business owners, and organizational leaders – to learn more about their perspectives and needs and how the City can better serve them. He was part of the Isaiah's Rock team awarded the California 2022 Nonprofit of the Year Award by Assembly Member Freddie Rodriguez.
