

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
CITY OF CHINO
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
GRANT (CDBG-CV)
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE ONE-
YEAR ACTION PLAN (FY 2019-2020)

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Chino will hold a public hearing on January 19, 2021 at 7:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, 13220 Central Avenue, Chino, CA. Action will be taken to amend the FY 2019-2020 One-Year Action Plan for the use of U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to include Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, (CARES Act) Funding.

In response to the Coronavirus Pandemic (COVID-19) the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) has notified the City of Chino that it will receive an allocation of \$457,388 to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus (COVID-19). This allocation was authorized by the CARES Act, Public Law 116-136, which was signed by President Trump on March 27, 2020, to respond to the growing effects of this historic public health crisis.

The Substantial Amendment details the proposed use of CDBG-CV3 funds \$457,388 to be allocated to the following eligible project/activities:

1. Extended Camp Scholarship Program - \$42,000
2. Distance Learning Homework Program - \$43,884
3. Senior Care Package Program - \$45,100
4. Emergency Rental Assistance Program - \$326,404

Pursuant to federal regulations, every CDBG activity must meet the requirements for one of the national objectives: 1) benefit low- and moderate-income persons; 2) prevent or eliminate slum or blight; 3) or meet an urgent need that poses a serious or immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community.

For CDBG-CV3 funding under FY 2019-2020, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act or CARES Act, may provide a 5-day notice/comment period of a proposed change beginning April 22, 2020 as allowed under a HUD waiver. This includes any new activities proposed.

The Substantial Amendment to the One-Year Action Plan for FY 2019-2020 is made available for a 5-day citizen review from January 11, 2021, to January 15, 2021.

Additionally, please note that Pursuant to Executive Order N-29-20, issued by Governor Newsom this noticed public hearing may be held via a remote teleconference system. If the January 19, 2021 meeting is to be held via a teleconference system, then participation instructions may be obtained by visiting www.cityofchino.org/calendar and selecting the January 19, 2021 meeting date.
