



### What is a "Jump Start" meeting?

A "Jump Start" meeting is an opportunity for business owners who are considering opening, relocating, or expanding a business in the City of Chino to meet with the city. At this meeting, business owners learn about the important issues and concerns regarding their business idea, permit requirements, and available resources to aide them through the process.

### What are the benefits of a "Jump Start" meeting?

- The City of Chino has discovered that working with a business early in the development process saves time and money for businesses.
- It is easier to paint the bigger picture at the beginning and be aware of the regulations, issues, and concerns before the business owner proceeds with the idea.
- At the "Jump Start" meeting, you will be informed of potential regulations, permits, and fees that may be required to operate.
- Business owners will have the opportunity to meet knowledgeable staff and build a relationship with them to better facilitate the process.

### Who attends a "Jump Start" meeting?

Representatives from various departments may include:

- Building and Safety Division
- Business License Division
- Economic Development Division
- Engineering/Transportation Division
- Environmental Division
- Fire Department
- Outside agencies
- Planning Division
- Police Department
- Utilities Agencies

## You should consider a "Jump Start" meeting if:

- You are not sure about the requirements involved in opening a business in the City of Chino.
- Your operation desires to process, handle, store, or discharge hazardous materials, including chemicals and solvents.
- You plan to use large capacities of water, gas, electricity and/or will discharge to the "brine line."
- You need to discharge any waste other than domestic waste to the sewer system.
- You might generate hazardous waste at your site.
- You weld or cut metal.
- You store flammable liquids.
- You sand, cut, or shape wood.
- You would be receiving large logistics/delivery vehicles to your facility.
- You plan on adding new features to your operations, but are not sure if it will be allowed.
- You wish to work or store materials outside the enclosed buildings at your location.
- You hope to add machinery, equipment, or storage units outdoors or on your roof.
- You perform any type of recycling procedures.
- You apply spray paint, varnish, lacquer, or coatings.
- You will be operating from your home.
- You store materials higher than 6 feet from the floor.
